### **Advertisement for redistribution of Taxi permits in MMRTA area - 2014**

Applications are invited from eligible applicants who wish to apply for grant of taxi permits out of cancelled/ lapsed/ not renewed permits from Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Transport Authority, Area.

#### **Time Table for Online Form Submission**

- 1) Period for filing online applications:- From 06<sup>th</sup> September 2014 at 03.00 pm to 20<sup>th</sup> September 2014 upto 06.00 pm
- 2) Online Payment facility will be available from 06<sup>th</sup> September 2014 at 03.00 pm to 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2014 upto 02.00 pm
- 3) **Processing fee for online application form is Rs. 100/- (Nonrefundable)**

#### **The number of permits available for redistribution - 7843**

Note: - The number of permits may vary.

#### **I. Eligibility Criteria**

1. Applicant should be a citizen of India.
2. Age limit : - On the date of application, the age of the applicant should be 20 years and above.
3. Educational Qualification: - Applicant must be 10<sup>th</sup> standard pass, however if enough number of applications of 10<sup>th</sup> pass candidates are not received, then the applicants, who are 8<sup>th</sup> standard pass, would be considered.

#### **II. General Terms and Conditions are as follows**

1. Applicant should be resident of Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Transport Authority (MMRTA) area and should hold driving license having present residential address in MMRTA area Permit will be granted by the office in whose jurisdiction the applicant resides. Area of operation of the permit will be total MMRTA area. e.g. Applicant residing in Panvel city will have Driving License & badge having address from Panvel city & issued by RTO, Panvel. Taxi Permit will be issued by RTO, Panvel valid for whole of the MMRTA area.

MMRTA area means MMR area as defined in schedule 1 of 'The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority Act, 1974'.

2. Applicant should hold valid LMV (Tr) or Transport Vehicle (HGV/HPV) driving license and public service vehicle authorization (badge) for taxi or auto rickshaw issued by RTO/ Dy RTO office in MMRTA area as on the date of submission of application.

3. Applicant shall have knowledge of local language (Marathi) and local topography.
4. Applicant should have stayed in Maharashtra for at least 15 years continuously.
5. Successful applicant shall have to produce certificate from Police Department (Police Station in whose jurisdiction he/she is staying) stating that no cognizable offence is registered against him/her during the last one year.
6. Successful applicant shall have to produce self-declaration stating that he/she is not in the service of Government/Semi Government/Private Company or any other organisation/firm (organized sector).
7. Successful applicant shall produce self-declaration stating that he/she is not holding another auto rickshaw/taxi permit in his/her name.
8. There is no reservation for any type of class or person.

### **III. About the taxi to be endorsed on the permit**

1. Taxi to be endorsed on permit shall be operated on CNG in Mumbai & in areas outside Mumbai where CNG pumps are available & on LPG/ Petrol in rest of area.
2. Fitment of digital electronic fare meter at prominent place so as to be clearly visible to all passengers with printer of approved type is mandatory.
3. The vehicle to be endorsed on the permit shall be a new taxi.
4. In future if Government/ Transport Commissioner/Concerned Authority decides to make it mandatory the fitment of GPS/GPRS, RFID Tag, Tachometer, Roof Top Indicator etc. in taxi, the permit holder shall have to install it on his/her own.
5. If an applicant submits more than one application, all his/her applications shall be treated as cancelled and the applicant will not be eligible for further selection process or the lottery draw.
6. Display of RTO complaint (Toll Free) Numbers, Police and Women's helpline numbers at prominent place so as to be clearly visible to all passengers is mandatory.
7. Display of colour copy of Permit along with driver's license at prominent place so as to be clearly visible to all passengers is mandatory.

### **IV. Procedure to fill up online application.**

1. Only online applications would be accepted for the grant of taxi permits as per this advertisement.

2. An eligible candidate can fill up web based online application form available on [www.taxipermit.mahaonline.gov.in](http://www.taxipermit.mahaonline.gov.in) from 06<sup>th</sup> September 2014 at 03.00 pm to 20<sup>th</sup> September 2014 at 06.00 pm
  - 2.1 Lottery draw will be carried out from eligible applications received. Tentative date for the lottery draw is 10<sup>th</sup> October 2014. or any other subsequent date.
  - 2.2 Result of lottery draw will be published on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2014 or subsequent date, on Transport Department's as well as on MahaOnline's website.
  - 2.3 Lottery winners/ selected applicants should submit original documents to concerned Regional Transport Office before 31<sup>th</sup> October 2014. After the verification of the documents, the concerned offices will start issuing letters of intent for taxi permits from 13<sup>th</sup> October 2014.
3. Detailed instructions regarding filling up online application form are available on [www.taxipermit.mahaonline.gov.in](http://www.taxipermit.mahaonline.gov.in) website.
4. The applications will not be considered for lottery/selection process unless processing fee is paid.
5. Processing fee can be paid through:
  - 1) Net Banking
  - 2) Debit Card
  - 3) Credit Card
  - 4) Sangram/CSC (Citizen Service Center) of Mahaonline
6. The list of Sangram Centers (in Grampanchayat) and Citizen Service Centers is available on [www.mahaonline.gov.in](http://www.mahaonline.gov.in) website.
7. Applicant can use the application format either in English or in Marathi, through the option available on screen.
8. Applicants should mention full residential address along with correct PIN code.
9. Mentioning accurate contact number of applicant i.e. mobile number is mandatory.
10. If the applicant is having PAN Card / or is having or applied for Aadhar Card, it is mandatory for him/her to enter the numbers of the same in the application form.
11. After reading and understanding the declaration, click on "I agree" button.
12. OTP (One Time Password ) will be sent to applicant's Mobile Number for verification. Confirmation of OTP is mandatory.
13. Check the information filled for its correctness and only on satisfaction, click on "submit" button.
14. After the above step, click on "Pay now" button for payment of processing fee.

- V. MMRTA has appointed only MahaOnline as agency for acceptance of applications Applicants are advised not to deal with any other unauthorized persons/ agencies in this regard. MMRTA shall not be responsible for the consequences in such cases.
- VI. Online applications received after 06:00 p.m. on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2014 will not be considered for lottery draw.
- VII. If it is observed at any stage during scrutiny that any applicant has deliberately given wrong information, such application will be rejected summarily and Transport Department may take legal action against such applicant.
